Vitì' viyùughwan kat chan William Vittrekwa ditr'iinjòo Merika goovàazhii ànts'àt vahanh viyùughwan kat chan Charlie Shananzhaa akòo ts'àt ditr'iinjòo Mary Vee iinli' t'àngiinch'ù'. Tr'iinin nilii dài' shìk dachan tat diik'iidhàt gwàt July 12, 1968 dài' Agnes Vittrekwa vatr'òonjìk, Teetl'it Zheh gwizhìt. Diyùughwàn kat hàh shìk ddhah tat gòo dachan tat goovàh nàtr'ehdinjìk. Nihkhàh tr'agwa`hchih tł'ee shin dài' Nàgwìchootshik danh gogweech'in' ànts'àt gehiìt Tr'ih Choo Iintinh gwà'àn khaii dài' gogweech'in'. Vàdzaih jì' ddhah tat gichùundì' ts'àt nìlii tr'ahgàii eenjit. Łahch'ii hàh geetàk gwitr'it gògwiintri' gwàt srìigogwiindài'. Chùk gweendòo zrit yeenjì' Nàtaiinlaii danh uutsik tr'ahgàii geenjit t'agiinch'ùh. Khaii dài' jùk zrit zheh gwizhìt t'agiinch'ùh.

Shìk Andrew khyàh t'ah'ii, łuk kàadi'ii ànts'àt nìlzrì'. Chyaa ch'ok nilii dài' yi'eenjì' Hay River gwits'àt nìtr'inyahchih School eenjit khaii tik ezhìk t'iinch'ù' th'ee hee zhik gwìdì' Aklavik gwits'àt gichùundi' ihhèh geenjit.

K'anadik tł'ee chyaa njòo nilii dài' aii natr'ahdakak nilii kat goovàh nìdhìzhii, tr'oochìt yi'eendòk New York gwits'àt gichùujìl tł'ee chan Canada gwà'àn nìdhìzhìi. Tthak gwiizii ganadhindaii nùh ànts'àt geetàk agwaandàk. Łyaa niinzhùk dahthee chan natr'ahdakak.

Dahanh ts'àt doondee k'ìighe' nits'oots'àt dachan tat tr'agwandaii shagooniltinh nùh.



Andrew was born December 5, 1923; his parents were Mary (Shananzhaa) and Peter Neyando. His paternal grandparents were Old William Vittrekwa and Merika; Andrew's maternal grandparents were Charlie Shananzhaa and Mary (nee: Vee). Andrew trapped, fished and hunted all his life. In his childhood, Andrew went to Hay River School for three years and later on he attended school in Aklavik for a few years. When he was still a young man, Andrew returned to Fort McPherson. He used to travel all over the Mackenzie Delta and among the mountains with his parents.

Andrew married Agnes Vittrekwa (nee: Modeste) July 12, 1968 in Fort McPherson. His step-children are: Minnie, Irene, Walter and Doreen. They lived at Mouth of the Peel during the summer and moved up to Boat Landing during the winter and sometimes travelled the mountains for caribou. It was a lot of hard work in those days. Today, they live mainly at Nitainlaii to dry fish. During the winter months they can be found in town.

Andrew was on the NWT Paddle team that traveled throughout the US into cities like New York. They also traveled throughout Canada prior to the Centennial Canoe Races of 1970.

He was taught survival skills from his mother and his older brother.
