ts'àt Bella Alexie kat hàh yi'eenjì' Tr'atr'aataıı Tshık gwà'àn dıık'àgahthat. Nìch'ıt zhuu nılıh dàı' School gwits'àt heehah geenjit dizhehk'oo hàh tthak Aklavık gwits'àt gichùundì'. Tr'oochìt school nıhdànıınzhıh dàı' uunjıt k'yùu àhdàndaih kwaa gwàt veejii k'ìighe' khanh ts'àt guk'àanjık. Nıhkhan Tr'atr'aatau Tshik gwits'ee nagoojil chan Hannah ganadhındaıh. Ezhik danh zrıt tthak ts'àt geenjıt gwıtr'ıt goovàh gòonlii zrit nuh. Aii guuzhik dıtì' chihvyàh nanaa'ık eenjit ts'àt tr'ıınjık gehkhee ts'àt dahanh hàh gyah digootl'ii chan ganadhindaii nuh. Tr'atr'aataıı Tshık gwà'àn jıdıı ganaanjık lòo shìk shòh goonlih hàh ezhik danh t'unch'uh dài'.

Dıık'ıındhat tl'ee, ınıhlık gwà'àn gwitr'it t'agwah'in' ts'àt nagwidàdhat 1979 dài' dakhao hàh kheenjit gwitr'it t'agwit'al'in' tr'igiikhii zheh geenjıt ts'àt gukhu ts'ànuu gunlì'. Jıdiı eenjit t'agidi'ii, nihkhàtr'agwahchih dài', tr'iinin guuk'òo tr'igiinjii, k'eejit kat guuk'òo tr'ıgıınjıı, nan zhıt tr'ahchıh dàı', ts'àt jıdìı tthak geenjit nıhkhàh gwitr'it gogwàłtsaii. Hannah vıyùughwan kat ch'anuh hàh gwitr'it t'agogwah'ın' an guuk'ıh zrıt Hannah akòo t'ıdı'ıı ts'àt jùkwàa hee zhık gweedì' tthak geenjit giikhii dhidlit. Aii tł'ee Yukon College gwits'àt chùuzhii ts'àt dıgınjik adantl'oo eenjit gagooniltın ts'àt gı'gwadhan kwaa akòo ts'àt

shìk hàh gwitr'it gwiinchii gwizhìt gwiinli' zrit nuh.

Fort Smith gwizhìt Gwich'ın Ginjîk eenjit Gà'oonahtan dhidlit, Hannah zrit tr'iinin kat ts'àt nits'òots'àt dinjii zhuh k'yùu atr'adantl'oo gayuunìltin. Jùk gweendòo aii k'eejit kat gwiintl'òh school gwizhìt gwitr'it t'agogwah'ii ts'àt jidìi tthak geenjit giik'àgahaandal geenjit diinjidizhit.



Hannah Alexie was born in Trail Creek and raised by her parents Abraham and Bella Alexie. When Hannah was old enough to go to school, she and her family moved to Aklavik. Hannah went into school not knowing any English whatsoever but caught on very quickly thanks to her older sister. Hannah remembers returning to Trail Creek several times throughout her childhood. She and her family would stay in the bush, where she can remember there being plenty of work for everyone. She recalls helping her father fish and her mother set rabbit snares. Her memories of Trail Creek are abundant and filled with happiness.

As an adult, Hannah began working on her own in 1979 with her niece for the church. They would work together for weddings, baptisms, confirmations, funerals and for many other church gatherings. Both Hannah's parents were very spiritual and Hannah followed in their footsteps by means of working for the diocese of the Arctic and was ordained in the 1990's. Later in life, Hannah attended the Yukon College to learn how to write her native language which she admits was not only difficult but entailed lots of
